

## **Bullet Points from the South Region Committee Meeting November 2009**

It has been confirmed that only players holding **Active Handicaps** are eligible to enter EWGA Medal Competitions.

A questionnaire seeking information on the new format will be circulated to all golf clubs by EWGA in 2010.

EWGA wish to encourage all golf clubs to hold a Stableford competition once a year to raise funds for the EWGA Trust.

Due to the reduction of funds held in the EWGA Trust it will not be possible to award grants to help with the purchase of equipment.

EWGA wishes to encourage more entries both to the Seniors Championship and the Australian Spoons competitions. Also they wish to encourage members to sign up to the EWGA Electronic News Letter.

**Keep a watch out for further news on the Championships in 2010.**

**Red Alert** – There has been a change to the date for Junior County Match Week. It is now **16<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup> August 2010**.

**Hot News** – Where there is discrimination shown **by a county** against girls entering Women's Competitions, EWGA will **exclude** entry to County Match Week, effective from January 1<sup>st</sup> 2010.

There will be no refresher courses for Rules Observers! Candidates will need to keep updated by applying to any future Rules course.

The **Welcome Booklet** is ready for distribution. Delegates will be asked to give these to New Members initially. They should be available shortly.

All delegates should now be aware of the Amendments to the EWGA Articles and Memorandum to be put to the EWGA AGM as well as the resolutions for the changes to the LGU.
