CONDITIONS / QUALIFICATIONS AND FURTHER INFORMATION:

- 1 The competition will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf, as approved by the R & A of St Andrews and with the Local Rules of the Club.
- 2 All players shall have amateur status in accordance with the current Amateur Status Regulations of the R & A of St Andrews
- 3 All players shall be full members of a County Association within the Midlands North Region
- 4 No substitutions will be allowed if there is a waiting list
- 5 An up to date Active CONGU handicap certificate must be produced when checking in
- 6 A competitor shall not knowingly make use of any drugs to enhance performance. A list of Prohibited drugs is available from the EWGA office. Penalty for infringement is disqualification
- 7 Competitors must not engage a professional or assistant professional as a caddy. Penalty for breach of rules is disqualification
- 8 The ball must conform to the R & A Rules
- 9 Driving clubs must conform to the list issued by the R & A
- 10 Players shall walk at all times unless permitted to ride by the organizing committee, on production of a current medical certificate
- 11 Driving order to remain the same throughout the day
- 12 Distance measuring devices may not be used
- 13 The competition shall consist of 36 holes stroke play from the EWGA Medal Tees. There shall be a limit of 60 couples and the combined handicap shall not exceed 36
- 14 In the event of inclement weather, the Organiser reserves the right to decide over how many holes the competition is played and how the prizes are awarded
- 15 **Trophies & Prizes:**
 - a) The winners of the 36 hole nett score shall hold the Challenge Cups for 1 year
 - b) The winners of the 36 hole gross score shall hold the salvers for 1 year
 - c) Prizes will be awarded for other aggregate rounds of the morning and afternoon
 - d) In the event of a couple recording both the best nett and gross scores, they shall hold both trophies
for 1 year and receive the 1st nett prize
 - e) No couple shall receive more than one prize
 - f) All ties shall be decided on the last 18, 9, 6, 3 or 1 hole. As this is a 2 tee start competition, the last
holes are holes 10-18 (as recommended by the R & A)
- 16 Money will not be refunded after the draw has been made, unless places can be filled from the waiting list.
- 17 Food will be available during the day. Evening meals will be available and should be ordered before the event.
